Sparkling Wine

- 100 Famiglia Carafoli L'Onestà Lambrusco di Sorbara Dry Rosé NV**.....32
This is fresh, fun and clean and shows off with lots of tiny bubbles... What a perfect start to the evening to get the juices flowing.
- 101 Billecart Salmon Champagne Brut Réserve NV**.....125
40% Pinot Meunier, 30% Pinot Noir, 30% Chardonnay - made only from Grand Cru and Premier Cru vineyards sourced from 20 villages
- 102 Veuve Clicquot Brut Champagne "Yellow Label" NV**.....160

Vino Bianco Italiano

- 200 La Raia "Riserva Vigna Madonnina" Gavi 2019**.....45
Harvested 10 to 14 days later than the basic Gavi, This is broad yet focused on the nose, with an intense Chablis-like chalkiness; the palate possesses concentration and cling, with the chalk echoing and carrying the flavors of apricot and apples through an impressively lengthy finish.
- 201 Brovia Roero Arneis 2022**.....45
The sole white wine of the estate is produced in the Roero district from an 0.80 hectare plot in Vezza d'Alba. The grapes are briefly macerated for two to three weeks. The wine rests until the early spring months of the following year and is usually released to the market, after several months of bottle aging, in late summer/early fall.
- 202 Ficomontantino "Zacinta Revi" IGT Bianco Toscana 2022**.....54
70% Sauvignon Blanc 30% Sangiovese (vinified as a white wine). The Sangiovese was added for complexity and boy was that a good decision. What a fun wine!!!
- 203 Cascina Ebreo Sauvignon Blanc "Sinché" 2018**.....Limited.....54
A Sauvignon Blanc with Muscle!! Only 66 cs produced!! Cascina Ebreo is what we call a "Cult" wine producer. The quantities available here are extremely limited. Forget everything you know about Sauvignon Blanc and try this gem of a wine

Vino Rosso Italiano

- 300 Clementi Valpolicella Classico Superiore 2019**.....65
Clementi produces wine in a non-flashy, traditional style—a style that speaks of the inherent acidity and freshness obtainable in Valpolicella's high-altitude slopes of sandy chalk. Juicy, ripe, and judiciously powerful, this nonetheless comes across sleek and driving for the category, with foregrounded mineral elements and mouth watering acidity.
- 301 Aldo Viola "Moretto" Terre Siciliane Rosso 2019**.....65
50% Nerello Mascalese, 40% Perricone and 10% Syrah - which thrives in this zone's parched Sicilian heat. The wine is not filtered and only a small amount of sulfur dioxide is used. Medium-bodied and easy to drink, with red fruits, aromatic herbs and marine notes; on the palate it is juicy, rich and fresh, with true Mediterranean character.
- 302 Milziade Antano Montefalco Rosso DOC**.....55
Here we have in winemaking terms.. a "garage wine". There is a lack of intervention in the winery and no high-tech equipment in the cellar. Wine from this appellation is powered by the mighty Sagrantino grape. This is no slouch of a wine.
- 303 Il Censo "700" Nero d'Avola Terre Siciliane Rosso 2016**.....65
The "700" refers to the meters of altitude at which the Nero d'Avola is planted. This wine offers a beguiling combination of plushness and tension, with fruits in the dark-red part of the spectrum, and plenty of driving energy. Nero d'Avola can often be one-note even when it is perfectly delicious, but not here, as this shows the true potential of Nero d'Avola.
- 304 Tenuta di Valgiano "Palistorti" Rosso Lucchessi DOC 2019**.....Limited.....65
Sangiovese 70%, Merlot and Syrah 30% in varying percentages per annum - For most people it would be unfathomable not to have the TV but at Valgiano, there isn't one; Only the beautiful Lucchessi hills and the wonderful wines are the focus. For those who know Valgiano understand that the wine is worth the pleasure. Excellent concentration and purity of fruit and never overpowered with oak. This is a cult wine produced in some of the most beautiful hills in Italy.
- 305 Pacina "Pacina" Rosso Toscana 2015**.....Limited.....58
Biodynamic - The vines are planted in soil called "Tufa" and the wine is produced with absolute minimal intervention in the winery and above all in complete respect for the ecosystem. This is real Tuscan wine!
- 306 Ficomontanino "Bulgarelli" IGT Rosso di Toscana 2021**.....Limited.....60
This wine pulls you in multiple directions; it is both fresh and deep, both spicy and politely earthy, and its dark red fruits soar high, unfettered by cellar manipulations. The ever-versatile Sangiovese finds a new and lovely register here.
- 307 La Sala Chianti Classico DOCG 2019**.....58
An elegant Sangiovese from the Northern Valley of Chianti Classico subregion of Firenze. A wonderful expression of Sangiovese produced in this region.
- 308 Piemaggio "le fioraie" Chianti Classico DOCG 2019**.....65
Utterly textbook in character, it combines earth, bright fruit, and tangy acidity, with notable yet unforced concentration; it is a wine of balance and egoless drinkability.
- 309 Collemattoni Rosso di Montalcino DOC 2020**.....60
100% Sangiovese, An ideal starting point for understanding the true expression of the Montalcino wine area.
- 310 La Torre Rosso di Montalcino 2020**.....68
La Torre is what you think of when you think of Italian Wine!! An "old-school" style with loads of complexity and power but with an elegant touch. Complexity is the focus here.
- 311 Du Croppo "Damis" Cirò Rosso Classico Superiore Riserva**.....72
Produced exclusively from the Gaglioppo grape planted to steep hillside vineyards above and around the village of Cirò in the beautiful region of CALABRIA!!, Damis is a selection of the best grapes from the harvest. The wine is dense, showing the deep, plum-like fruit of the Gaglioppo. Oh... CALABRIA!!!
- 312 Cigliuti Barbera d'Alba "Campass" 2020**.....60
The Cigliuti family is a rock star of the Barbaresco Appellation. Quality fruit is the leading principle here and they certainly nail it here. Barbera is a very giving fruit as long as you know what to do with it and the Cigliuti's do!!
- 313 Hilberg - Pasquero Nebbiolo d'Alba DOC 2014**.....Limited.....95
Biodynamic - Nebbiolo is a grape with abundant tannin and an elegant structure and needs particular care in the ripening phase to become as caressing as this wine is. This wine is for those who admire the uniqueness of a great Nebbiolo
- 314 DeForville Barbaresco 2019**.....90
It is very difficult in this market to find a Barbaresco of great quality / price ratio.... But we have done it

- 315 Paolo Conterno “Riva del Bric” Barolo 2018.....95**
 Paolo Conterno is one of the rockstars in the Monforte d’Alba sub-region of Barolo. His vineyards are in the famous Grand Cru of Ginestra. A deeply respected producer in the Barolo wine community.
- 316 Ficomontanino "Seraphina" IGT Rosso Toscana 2019.....Limited.....100**
 Pure Sangiovese from 40-year-old vines—its first year of rest is spent in above-ground amphora, and its second year in steel. Bottled without fining or filtration and with a minimal dose of sulfur, this tiny-production wine offers a combination of depth and freshness that speaks to Sangiovese’s capacity for vivacity when it is not overhanded.
- 317 La Torre Brunello di Montalcino 2018.....Limited.....145**
 The big boy of Tuscan wine is Brunello di Montalcino!!! La Torre is what you think of when you think of Italian Wine!! Old school style with loads of complexity and power but with an elegant touch.
- 318 Begali Amarone Classico DOCG 2018.....160**
 This is a wine that receives praises every year from the Italian wine press. A jewel of the appellation of Valpolicella and a favorite of many is the beloved Amarone and Begali is nothing short of an experience!
- 319 Paolo Bea “San Valentino” Umbria Rosso 2018.....EXTREMELY LIMITED.....130**
 70% Sangiovese, 15% Sagrantino and 15% Montepulciano, all from a 50-year old vineyard. This wine is sourced from the San Valentino vineyard in Montefalco at 1300 feet altitude. The wine macerates for approximately 30 days. The wine is aged for 3 years in stainless steel and an additional 4 to 12 months in bottle before release. DPR gets one 6 pack per year!

French White Wine

- 400 Daniel-Etienne Defaix Chablis 1er Cru "Vaillons" 2009.....Limited.....80**
 The Defaix family owns a prime parcel of old vines (45 years of age) in the original cru—the Vaillon. The steep 28-degree gradient and iron-rich soils of this southeast-facing site render a wine of spicy richness, and this is a real powerhouse. Showing remarkable concentration and excellent acidity, this wine has a luscious quality. Chablis is one of our favorites!

French Red Wine

- 500 Le Puy “Duc des Nauves” Bordeaux Rouge 2020.....50**
 The culture and the vinification are carried out by the Château le Puy team following the same approach as with the grand cuvee of the estate: natural, organic and biodynamic. The wine is made up of 70% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon. Bottled without filtration after 12 months. The aromatic bouquet reveals black fruit, plum and cherry, well balanced between its freshness and velvety tannins.
- 501 Château Haut-Segottes Saint-Émilion Grand Cru.....80**
 Tradition reigns at Château Haut-Segottes. The majority of the vineyards are planted to Merlot, the ultimate cuvée bottled as Saint-Émilion Grand Cru features a majority of Cabernet Franc. This dominance of Cabernet Franc, frequently on the order of 65%, produces a wine of considerable structure and is exceptionally age-worthy.
- 502 Domaine Bois de Boursan Châteauneuf du Pape Rouge 2020.....120**
 Composed of 65% Grenache Noir, 15% Syrah, 15% Mourvèdre and a balance of other traditional varieties. The fruit is perfectly in balance with the textural elements, showing typical dark fruit notes with discernible energy and liveliness. Its slightly savage character and firm structural backbone is leavened by its exceptional breed.

California White Wine

- 700 Far Niente Chardonnay 2022.....120**
 A blend of superlative Napa Valley vineyards located in Coombsville, a cool growing region nestled in the rolling countryside and protected by the hills east of the city of Napa.
- 701 Château Montelena Chardonnay 2020.....120**
 During most growing seasons, the progression beginning with ripening in the vineyard and flowing through to harvest is methodical and calculated. With optimal Napa Valley climate, ideal soils and a stellar track record, here at Montelena this couldn’t be more true
- 702 Kistler Chardonnay 2021.....140**
 Kistler is a single clone chardonnay house. The Chardonnay was planted across fifteen vineyards; its parent material was imported from Burgundy in the early part of the 20th century. The fruit is harvested in the cool of the night, when the fruit is at its freshest and brightest, and the flavors and acidities are fully intact when the fruit is in a different physiological state at three in the morning than it is at mid-day, very different.

California Red Wine

- 703 Stag’s Leap Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2020.....110**
 Sourced primarily from cooler appellations within Napa Valley, this 2020 Cabernet Sauvignon is fresh and vibrant with layers of bright red berry fruits, alongside a floral potpourri. Baking spice notes of caramel, clove and cedar are also present, a nod to the well-integrated oak character.
- 704 Faust Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2021.....110**
 Aromas of fresh herbs, pungent cedar, and forest with more delicate floral notes, black pepper, bittersweet chocolate, and crushed rock. On the palate, blackberry flavors, and warmly spiced dark plum is layered with fresh herbs for a lively, sweet-savory balance. Fine tannins yield satisfyingly rich, velvety textures, vibrant acidity keeps you coming back for more.
- 705 Heitz Cellars Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2018.....120**
 Tucked against the Mayacamas mountains in the celebrated Oakville AVA, with fertile, well-drained soil and afternoon shade, this superior site is home to the unique proprietary cabernet clone which has brought this vineyard legendary status.
- 706 Cakebread Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2019.....150**
 A blend of Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon from special spots throughout the region, including the renowned cab appellations of Rutherford and Oakville, which impart classic Napa Valley bold fruit intensity, as well as the warmer Calistoga area to the north and the cooler southern reaches of the Suscol watershed, which contribute layers of complexity and depth of flavor.
- 707 Château Montelena Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2019.....200**
 Incredible history has taken place here at Chateau Montelena for their world renowned Chardonnay. With that said, it is just as gratifying to hit that pitch out of the park here again with the estate Cabernet Sauvignon which needs no introduction.
- 708 Caymus Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2021.....225**
 Caymus Vineyards is located in the center of the Napa Valley. Primary production is Cabernet Sauvignon grown on low-fertility soils on both the valley floor and the mountains that surround the valley. The estat’s attention to viticulture produces a unique and singular style of Cabernet not to be missed.
- 709 Joseph Phelps Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2019.....225**
 A wine of great energy, length, and finesse, opens with floral notes, cedar and pencil shavings followed by ripe blackberry, cassis and red currant jam. Fresh and focused with pleasing acid and tannin structure building tension along the palate to the lingering finish.
- 801 Heitz Cellars Trailside Vineyard Rutherford Cabernet Sauvignon 2015 MAGNUM 1.5L.....400**
 Since 1984, this outstanding vineyard has been part of the Heitz estate and produces one of our three, single-vineyard cabernet sauvignons. Nestled between Silverado Trail and Conn Creek on the fertile, eastern side of the Rutherford appellation, only the best blocks are selected for this terroir-driven cabernet sauvignon.
- 802 Chimney Rock Cabernet Sauvignon 2019 MAGNUM 1.5L.....400**
 The Chimney Rock Estate is blessed with a diversity of soil and topography that breeds complexity. To the east, the steep hills and shallow soils bring us density and power. On the north end, the proximity to the Palisades gifts the wine with ripeness and purity of fruit. To the south, the proximity to the bay brings breezes that add the nuance of cooler climate—adding hints of dried herbs and mint. It is this diversity that provides the quintessence between grace and power, the balance of finesse and muscle.
- 803 Il Poggione Brunello di Montalcino 2017 DOUBLE MAGNUM 3L.....550**
 Brunello is the prince of Montalcino wines, produced exclusively from Sangiovese grapes picked by hand from the oldest vines in the farm. After a careful fermentation at controlled temperature, Tenuta Il Poggione Brunello di Montalcino is aged in French oak barrels. After being aged in wood, the wine is bottle aged:
